WHAT WE DO

We provide event organisers across the length and breadth of the UK with access to a pool of highly experienced marshals who are trained in the latest techniques and regulations. We set up and run stages, we run time controls, marshal in stage and provide safety and communications cover.

We cover events of all sizes from the World Rally Championship to local club events, and whilst the forests are our historic 'home', increasingly we are actively involved with the latest generation of closed-road events.

The BRMC was formed in 1980 as a rally-focussed special interest group within the BMMC, a position that we still occupy today.

TRAINING

The BRMC runs a number of training days each year which are free to attend. All of our trainers are Motorsport UK approved. They cover all you need to know to get started as a Rally Marshal through to what is needed to act as a Stage Commander / Senior Official, and everything in between.

The BRMC also runs additional training days and evenings on behalf of other motor clubs. You provide the enthusiasm and we will provide the skills.

GRADING

BRMC and BMMC are recognised administrators of the grading schemes provided by Motorsport UK. We provide assistance and advice to help you gain the necessary knowledge, attitude, skills and experience to become a successful marshal in any discipline.

These schemes are controlled by the governing body and apply to all clubs and all marshals. All grading materials covering rallies, circuits, speed events and karting can now be downloaded from the Motorsport UK website.
